CHOIR PRACTICE: Is at 10am every Sunday before the Strathaven service.

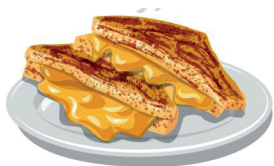
LADIES CRAFTING: Takes place on Wednesdays 1:30pm – 3:30pm in Chapelton
